The era of the oligarchs is nearing its end. If U.S. and European sanctions and <u>freeze and</u> seize measures don't wipe out the Russian captains of industry, Vladimir Putin's consolidation of power will. Andrej Babiš of Agrofert is eying the presidency and doubling down. Yet the process of deoligarchization will eventually come to the Czech environment too. Oligarchs played a key roll in the rapid transformation from state to private control; and so they will too on the reverse path.
